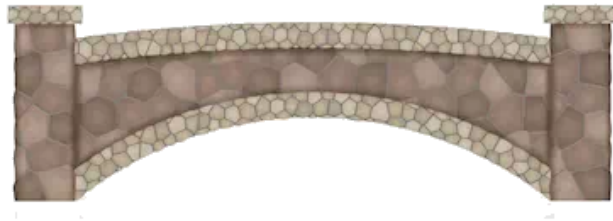


Positional Words



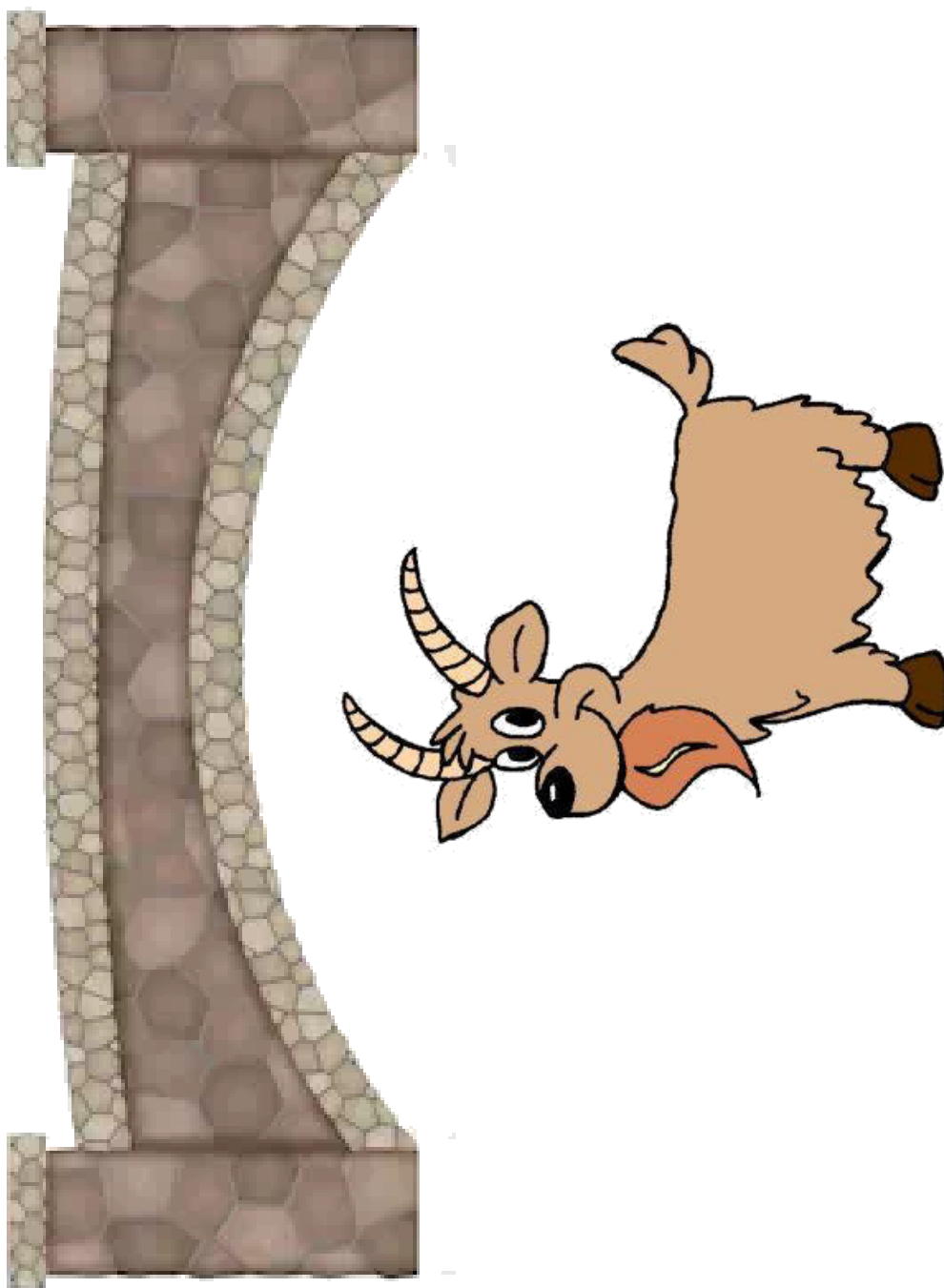
These fun sheets are designed to help teach young ones about direction.

Directions

Turn the bridge **upside down**.

Put the goat in **front** of the bridge.

Move the goat **behind** the bridge.

Move the goat to the **top** of the bridge.

Walk the goat **over** the bridge.

Move the goat **under** the bridge.

Put the goat **beside** the bridge.

Move the goat **near** the bridge.

Move the goat **far** away from the bridge.
