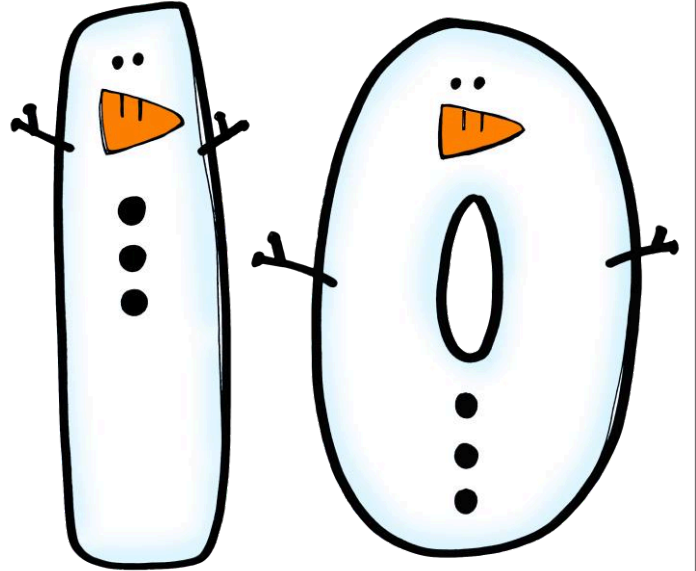
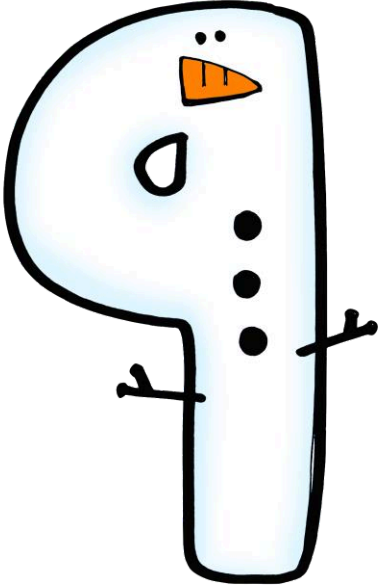
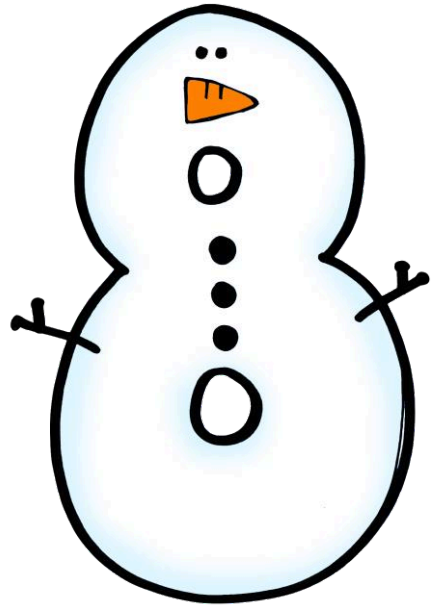
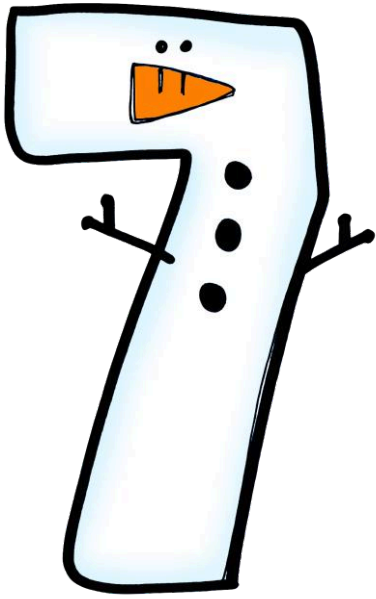


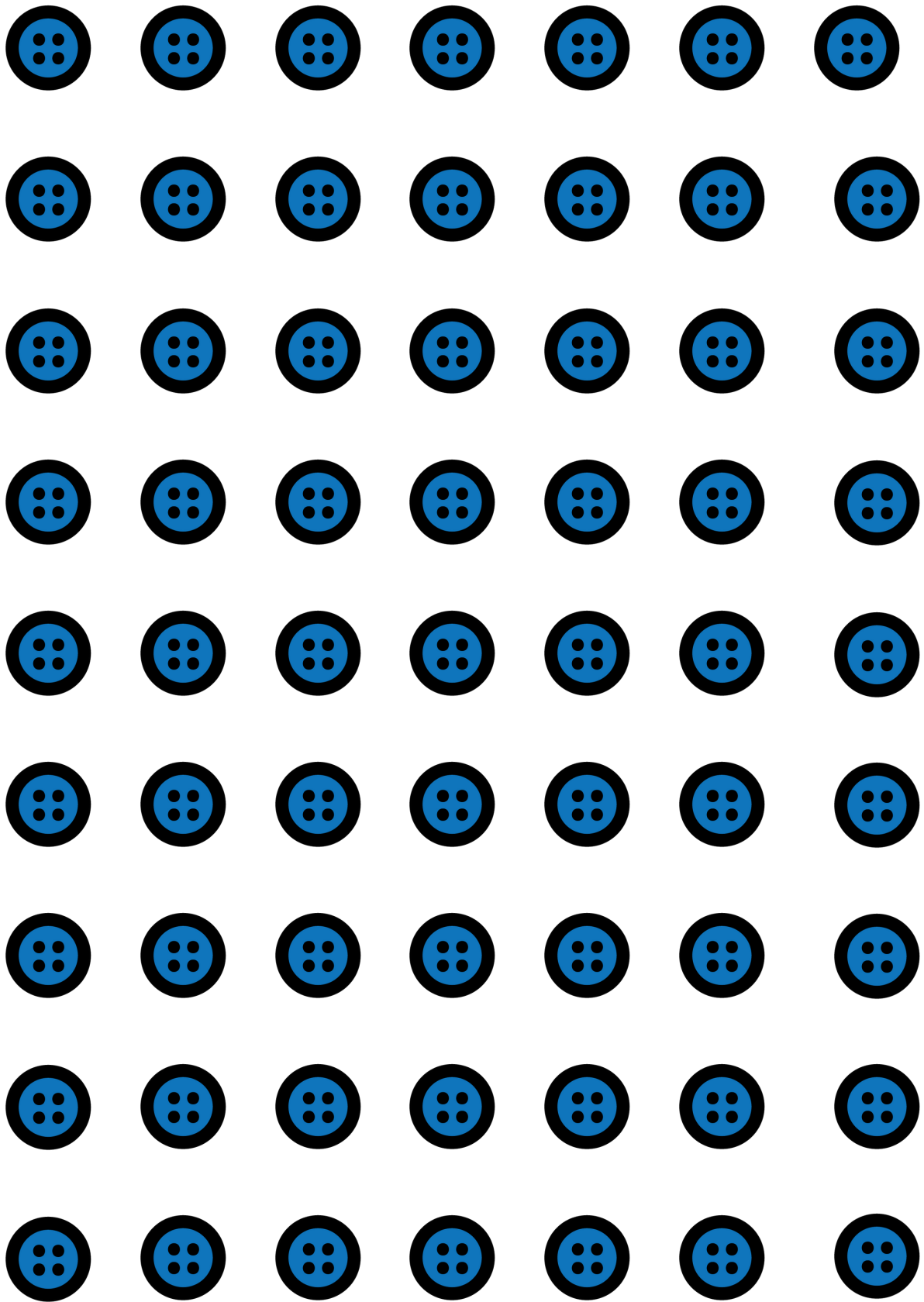












## Ideas and Suggestions

Print pages 1-7. Cut apart and laminate the cards on pages 2-6. Cut the buttons out on page 7 if those are what you will be using for manipulatives. Place one or both sets of cards in a sensory bin.

Another way to play is to simply put the cards on the table. Provide the ten-frame mat and some small manipulatives. Invite students to choose a card, identify the number or count the buttons, and then fill in the ten frame accordingly.

Here are a couple of variations for this resource: Match the snowman number card to the matching snowman ten frame card. Choose a set of cards and place them in order.

Place the snowman number cards on a tray with a cup of stacking manipulatives. Invite students to identify the number and count and stack accordingly.
